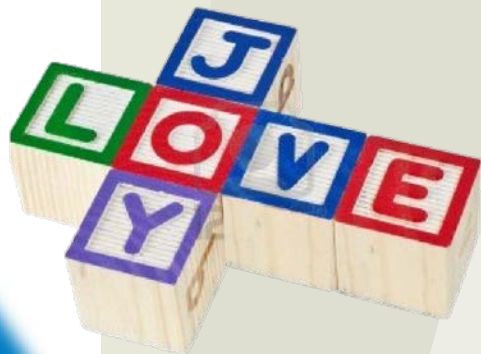
## Parental Information:

- Please complete the child information form prior to check-in.
- Nursery check-in available 10-15 minutes prior to worship services.
- Required items for diaper bag: diapers, wipes, plastic bag for wet clothes, change of clothes, clean bib, bottle *or* “sippy” cup. [Labeling prior to arrival is greatly appreciated.]
- Please pick up your child or children immediately following the service.
- All children cry. We understand and expect it, please let us know your requests and concerns. If your child continues to cry for 5 min. or more we will notify the parent/guardian.
- Nursery toys/equipment are sterilized weekly.



## Food/Snacks:

- All food/bottles must be labeled with the child's name. No church snack is provided (e.g. cookies) unless parent gives permission.
- Please indicate what time you desire your baby to receive a snack or bottle on the sign-in sheet.
- **If your child has a food allergy or a special need related to food, please notify the nursery staff.**
- A nursing area is provided for nursing mothers.



## Illness:

- Sick children need tender loving care from Mom/Dad at home please.
- If your child or children have had a fever in the past 24 hours, or are showing signs of illness (runny nose, diarrhea, or watery eyes) out of respect and consideration for the other children and families they will not be admitted into the Nursery.
- If your child develops a fever or other illness, a nursery assistant will come for you immediately.
- No medications will be given to any child in the program (including over the counter medications)
- ***Parents should report any allergies to the nursery caregivers.***

### Staff of NFBC Nursery will gladly:

- Assist you with Check-In.
- Provide a clean & safe environment for your children.
- Release child to the parent /guardian
- Notify the parent/guardian if child is ill.
- Notify parent /guardian if the child cries more than 5 minutes.
- Feed child as directed by parent/guardian.
- Provide an age appropriate snack and drink if approved by parent/guardian.
- And most importantly: Hold, nurture, care, play with and teach children in the nursery.
