On December 6, 2005 my five brothers and I had the unenviable task of carrying to the grave, the casket that held the body of the woman who gave each of us life! She was a remarkable woman who blessed all those she came in contact with, and I truly thank God that He ordained that special lady to be my mother. My oldest brother, in delivering her eulogy, included these words: *"I don't think her name will probably be written about in books, but I think that where it really counts, her name is among the "who's who" in the kingdom of God!"*
